

Step 1: Access ICA website, select "Pass holder"




Step 2: Select and click "Institutes of Higher Learning"





Note: For Nationality, please select "Chinese" for Hong Kong SAR / Macau SAR.








Step 6: Click on "Submit eForm 16" and fill up the necessary information.








Step 8: Upload the necessary documents and click "Proceed".


Note: For the travel document, ensure you upload a clear image of the full biodata page (the first page of the travel document).



Step 9: Confirm the information and click "Submit" at the bottom of the page. Please note that once submitted, eForm 16 cannot be amended.



Step 10: Click "Make Payment" and select your preferred payment method (internet banking or credit/debit card) to pay the \$45 processing fee.




Step 11: ICA will process your application within 1-2 weeks, but some applications may take longer. To check the status of your application, select "View Application Status".

Note: Please check your email regularly and upload any clarification documents to the ICA SOLAR System within 14 days of receiving the notification. Failure to respond to ICA's clarifications may lead to the withdrawal of the application. Application outcome will be notified through email. Please also check your Junk/Spam folder for any emails from ICA.



Step 12: Once the Student Pass application is approved, click on "Print Outcome Letter" to generate the IPA letter, which must be presented to the Immigration Officer upon arrival at the Singapore checkpoint.



## Final Step:

Log in to the <u>ICA SOLAR system</u> to complete the next 3 steps for the completion of formalities (COF) (upload documents, make payment and make appointment)

- 1. Log in to the ICA's **SOLAR** system
- 2. Select "View Application Status"
- 3. Upload the fully completed medical examination report (if applicable or for courses more than 6 months) and the terms and conditions of the student Pass

For <u>medical examinations done overseas</u>, please ensure you upload the full set of medical examination reports (ICA prescribed medical examination form), including the laboratory report for HIV and the X-ray report:

- a) The student's details (as shown in the travel document) are correctly stated in the medical examination report and relevant laboratory reports.
- b) The stamp of the overseas clinic is endorsed on the medical examination report
- c) The name of the examining doctor and the date of the medical examination are clearly stated
- d) An official English translation of the medical report is provided if it is written in a foreign language


For <u>medical examination done in Singapore</u>, please upload the complete medical examination report, including the laboratory reports.

4. Submit COF documents for ICA's processing

**Note:** Please check your email regularly and upload any clarification documents to the ICA SOLAR System within 14 days of receiving the notification. Incomplete documents will result in withdrawal of the IPA.

- 5. Once ICA approves the documents, the applicant will receive an email notification to make the payment for the issuing fee.

## **Booking of e-appointment**



## **Important Note:**

Completion of STP formalities is strictly by **appointment ONLY**; the ICA will not assist students who walk-in without a prior e-appointment. Please ensure your appointment with the ICA is scheduled before your social visit pass / IPA expiry date, whichever is earlier.

If the e-appointment date is after your social visit pass validity, you must extend your social visit pass through the ICA website. Overstaying is a punishable offence under the Immigration Act.
