### **MOE Subsidy**

SCs and SPRs undergraduates pursuing part-time programmes who meet the following criteria are eligible for the MOE subsidy:

- Must not have previously received a government-subsidised/sponsorship for an undergraduate degree or higher qualification (local or overseas), from SUSS/NUS/NTU/SMU/SUTD/SIT or from an overseas university funded by government scholarship/bursary and
- Be at least 21 years of age;
- Have 2 years of full-time work experience or have fully discharged their full-time NS

<sup>1</sup> In line with MOM's definition last revised on 1 Jan 2009, a full-time employee is one who works for more than 35 hours a week under contract of service with an employer.
