

Insurance Cover for Research Subjects

Research subjects participating in NTU-IRB approved studies are now covered under a university-wide insurance policy for **bodily injuries** sustained during the course of the research study. This is effective for all existing IRB -approved studies and for new studies moving forward.

Please note that this insurance only covers studies involving **physical interventions** (e.g. exercise, blood draws, brain scans, etc). For new studies involving such physical interventions, PIs should use the updated HBR consent forms to recruit participants. [[Click here](#) for more info.]



Guidelines for Principal Investigators



- Use [HBR consent form template](#) for high risk projects or for studies involving interventions.
- State in the consent form that compensation is available in the event of injury arising from their participation in the research involving interventions.
- Inform research subjects to contact PIs or study team members if they wish to file a claim.
- Notify the IRB Secretariat at IRB@ntu.edu.sg as soon as possible in the event of a claim or a potential claim arising.
