Connecting Research with Ethics

Planning to supply or transfer **Human Tissues** to NTU/non-NTU **Collaborators** for use in research?

IRB (Institutional Review Board) Supply/ Transfer/ TBB (Tissue Banking Board) TAC (Tissue Access Committee Provision/ Export **IRB** Identifiable Satellite TB Collabora **Owner** Non-identifiable tors/ **TBB** / PI **Partners** Non-identifiable **TAC**

As required by the <u>Human Tissue Framework (HTF)</u> of the Human Biomedical Research Act (HBRA), Researchers must ensure the following before supplying <u>Human Tissues</u>:

Individually Identifiable Tissues

a) An IRB 1 has approved the proposed research that the tissue would be used for; and

Non-Identifiable Tissues

- a) NTU-TBB (2), or a TAC (3) if available, has approved the proposed research based on scientific merit; and
- b) **documentary evidence*** is provided by the recipient that they will use the tissue in accordance with the conditions/restrictions specified as part of the donors' consent.



NEW Updated MTA Template

Use the latest *Material Transfer Agreement (MTA) template by LSO (updated clause 3.3) to fulfil HBRA's requirement for "documentary evidence". The MTA must be signed by **both** the recipient and institutional signatory.

Important Note

Export of Identifiable Tissues

If you intend to export individually-identifiable tissue out from Singapore, <u>explicit</u> <u>consent</u> must be obtained from the donor prior to the export.

Release of Non-Identifiable Tissues

To obtain non-identifiable tissues from a Tissue Bank (TB) Owner/PI, Tissue Requestors can complete a <u>Tissue Release Form</u> and submit it to the NTU-TBB via <u>ServiceNow</u> (Research Services > Human Tissue Withdrawal). The TB Owner/PI is to retain a copy of the final completed signed form from the requestor.
