HBRA UPDATES TO RESEARCH AGREEMENT TEMPLATES

Conducting research that involve a: Project Agreement (PA) with Public Sector Organisations; or Research Collaboration Agreement (RCA) with Industry/Companies or Research Institutes?

In collaboration with LSO (Legal and Secretarial Office), NTU's Research Agreement Templates have been updated with additional clauses to facilitate further compliance to HBRA's requirements.

The appointment of "**Lead RI**" and "Common IRB".


The Lead RI must notify MOH within 30 days if it ceases to be the Lead RI.

If there is a change in the Lead RI, the Lead RI must also inform MOH of the identity of the substitute Lead RI in its notification.

Each Project Party is **severally responsible** to comply with the HBRA requirements even after the Lead RI has notified MOH on its cessation as the Lead RI.

Material Transfer Agreement Template

Supplying/Transferring/Providing/Exporting Human Biological Materials for Research?



Regardless of whether the tissue is individually-identifiable or non-identifiable, under HBRA, documentary evidence* must be provided by the receiving party.

*The receiving party must ensure that the intended use of the tissue is in accordance with any restrictions/conditions of the donors' appropriate consent.

To fulfil HBRA's requirement for "documentary evidence", use the latest Material Transfer Agreement (MTA) template provided by LSO. The MTA must be signed by the recipient, in addition to the institutional signatory.
