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Connecting Research with Ethics

1. Ethics Approval for Student Research

Students conducting research on human participants and their supervisors should note the various requirements for ethics approval in NTU.

	PG by research	UG and PG by Coursework	Non-NTU students	Student groups, societies, halls
Examples	Ph.D/ M.A./ M.Sc students by research.	FYP, URECA, PG critical inquiry students by coursework.	JC/ IP/NRP students conducting research in NTU.	School clubs, interest-based clubs, hall councils.
Review requirement	NTU-IRB approval required.	Can be reviewed by School's ERC.	NTU-IRB or School's ERC approval required.	To check with faculty supervisor or hall master.

2. Requirements for Student PI, Faculty Supervisor




PIs have **overall responsibility** over the conduct of their research involving human subjects.



Students can be named as "Student PI" for student-led projects, but the student's faculty supervisor **must** be named in the "PI" section on IRB applications.
