



# HBRA HUMAN BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH ACT


### HTF HUMAN TISSUE FRAMEWORK



The Human Biomedical Research Act (HBRA) governs all human biomedical research in Singapore. It also regulates tissue banks and tissue banking activities under the Human Tissue Framework (HTF).

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If you are conducting tissue banking activities (e.g. storage, import and export of human tissue) that is not part of an IRB-approved HBRA study, you need to complete the HTF Declaration/Notification Form.

Contraventions of the above legislation may result in legal penalties if found guilty of an offence.
