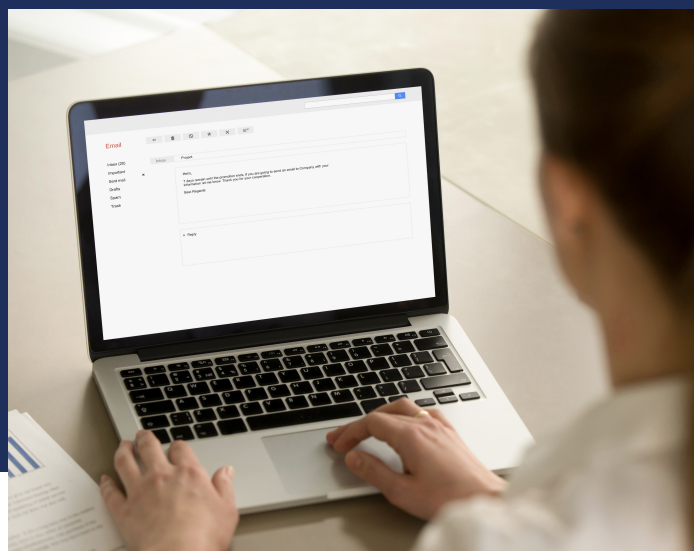
## IMPROPER RESEARCH INVOLVING HUMANS

- 1 *Studies conducted on human participants without IRB approval*
- 2 *Research participants being subjected to additional interventions unapproved by the IRB*
- 3 *Coercion or undue influence of potential research participants*
- 4 *Misuse of collected personal data or human tissues that does not meet its original research intent*

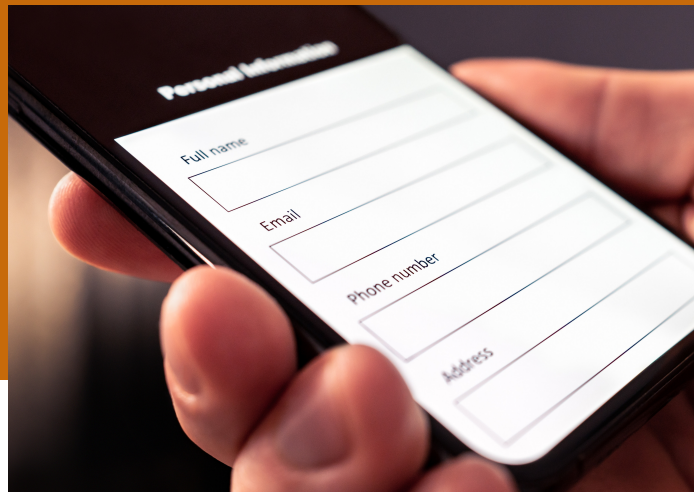


## ANONYMOUS REPORTING
