Alert team members of confidential research data handling via **DATA MANAGEMENT PLAN** and **UNDERTAKING FORM**.

HANDOVER of research data by **DEPARTING** team members.

Share non-sensitive research data via **DR-NTU (DATA)** & include the **DATASET DOI** in **DATA AVAILABILITY STATEMENT** of your journal paper.

Comply with **REQUIREMENTS** stipulated by **GRANT AGENCIES**.

Open Access Week (23–29 Oct 2023) serves as a reminder that the greatest benefit of open access is to enable the results of scholarly research to be accessible by more people, including those who cannot afford the subscription to expensive journals.

There are a few pathways to achieve Open Access. You could either go with Gold Open Access (see NTU Library's article processing charges support) or Green Open Access by archiving your publication in **DR-NTU**.
