Intakes and Application Period

August Intake – 01 October to 15 November, For all four Subject Areas
January Intake – 01 June to 15 July, For Economics, Psychology and Sociology only

Application

Only the **first choice** of the application will be processed. Candidates who wish to be considered for more than one subject will have to submit separate applications. If you wish to be considered for either MA or PhD, separate applications must be submitted. Application fee is payable for every application.

When applying, it is important to provide your email address and contact no. so that we can contact you regarding interviews. Ensure that both email and contact no. are valid.

Admissions Requirements

Admissions Eligibility

Applicants must have Bachelor's degree with minimum Honours (Distinction) or 2nd Class Upper Honours or equivalent and the ability to pursue research in the proposed field of advanced study.

IELTS / TOEFL

For applicants whose native language is not English, **IELTS** or **TOEFL** test scores must be submitted.

- Test dates must be **within 2 years or less** from the date of application.
- Those who hold a degree from universities (must be at least 3 years of study) where English is the medium of instruction are exempted from the IELTS/TOEFL requirement. A letter from the university indicating the medium of instruction as English must be submitted.

The minimum score requirements for the tests are:

- IELTS: 7.0 (on all subtests)
- TOEFL (iBT): 105 out of 120
- TOEFL (PBT): 580 out of 677

GRE

GRE test scores are required for admissions to **Economics** and **Psychology**. Test date must be **within 5 years or less** from the date of application. GMAT scores are not acceptable.

Economics

Minimum requirement:

- Verbal & Quantitative Reasoning 319 out of 340
- Analytical Writing 3.5 out of 6.0
- GRE is **not** required from NTU, NUS or SMU graduates.

Psychology

Minimum requirement:

- Verbal & Quantitative Reasoning 319 out of 340
- Analytical Writing 3.5 out of 6.0
- GRE is **not** required from NTU, NUS or SMU graduates.

Applicants (including NTU, NUS or SMU graduates) without prior training in Psychology must submit GRE in Psychology Test Results.

Interviews are scheduled between November to December (August Intake) and July to August (January Intake) for shortlisted candidates only and they are conducted via Zoom.

4. IELTS / TOEFL

8. Two Academic Referees' Reports

- Applicants are encouraged to prompt referees to submit report online on time to avoid delays in processing applications.
- Referee report should be typed on a letterhead and duly signed.
