

## Specialisation in Public Policy – AY2021 intake and after

### Description:

As the requirements of the program are very demanding, it is necessary to impose a minimum grade requirement, to ensure that students enrolled in the program will be able to cope with these demands. Thus, only students whose CGPAs are above 3.75 will be eligible to apply.
