Term Paper Assignment

To earn NTU credit, each student is to submit a term paper based on any global sustainability topics of interest with special emphases on activities in Singapore or the region.

Format of the term paper:

- Maximum 2 pages of text (A4 paper)
- 1 inch margins (top, bottom, left, right)
- 1.5 line spacing for text, 1 line spacing for figure legends
- Font: Arial size 10 for text, size 9 for figure legends
- The term paper should include a short background on the specific global sustainability issue (1 paragraph) and can be an in the form of opinions, perspectives, or a factual summary of the progress/challenges of the issue.

The term paper is due on 22 November 2024 and to be submitted on NTULearn Turnitin portal.
