

## ADRFI-2 Programme Concluding Workshop on Risk Assessment and Risk Financing Pillars

12 July 2023, Yogyakarta, Indonesia Yogyakarta Marriott Hotel, 0900 - 1700 (GMT +7)

#### **SYNOPSIS**

Natural catastrophe (NatCat) losses from natural disasters in the ASEAN region are often underor un-insured and often overwhelm Governments' current risk bearing capacity. This leaves a
substantial part of the loss to be borne by society, which further strains Governments' budget in
providing disaster relief and subsequent reconstruction. ASEAN has in recent years stepped up
collective efforts towards regional Natural Catastrophe (NatCat) disaster relief and risk mitigation
with the ASEAN Disaster Risk Financing and Insurance (ADRFI) Roadmap developed in 2011. The
ASEAN Disaster Risk Financing and Insurance – Phase 2 (ADRFI-2) Programme initiated under this
Roadmap has an overall goal of strengthening ASEAN's disaster risk management capabilities,
complementing the efforts of public-private disaster risk financing and insurance solutions. ADRFI2 as approved by the ASEAN Finance Ministers at the ASEAN Finance Ministers Meeting in April
2018, has pillars that focus on Risk Assessment and Risk Financing Advisory that are led by the
Institute of Catastrophe Risk Management (ICRM), Nanyang Technological University (NTU),
Singapore.

Under ADRFI-2, ICRM has been working closely with ASEAN Member States (AMS) participating in ADRFI-2 via a series of bilateral engagements and workshops that focused on a stock-take and assessment of AMS' individual portfolio of NatCat risks, and on the AMS risk bearing capacity and risk financing options. Together with ACSCC-DRFI, four ADRFI-2 Workshops have been held to date on the ADRFI-2 outcomes. An ADRFI-2 Platform has further been developed for an online risk analysis. This Platform allows AMS to interactively view their risk exposure and explore risk financing options, the latter via an embedded Risk Financing Toolkit. A series of workshops on Platform use has been conducted, with the most recent being Train-the-Trainers (T3) workshops conducted bilaterally with 6 AMS. Platform outputs are expected to be useful to inform on cost efficiency of financing options and support prioritization of risks from national development and economic perspectives.

This ADRFI-2 Concluding Workshop on 12 July 2023 will mark the conclusion of the ADRFI-2 Programme by having presentations of ADRFI-2 achievements to the ACSCC-DRFI and other ASEAN agencies present. Presentations by international organizations on DRFI implementation and challenges are also included. Regional and sub-regional risk pooling possibilities as supporting collective financial resilience against natural disasters will also be presented and discussed. Lastly, a Platform Training Session is also scheduled following the main Workshop program, reinforcing the recently conducted T3 workshops.
