2	<p><u>Integration with Academic and Clinical Training</u></p> <p>The nominee should demonstrate an ability to balance research activities with their academic and/or clinical training, showing how research has been integrated into their overall medical education and future career planning.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>i. Nominee should submit a personal statement on how research experiences have influenced academic and career goals.</li><li>ii. Feedback from academic or clinical supervisors on the nominee's ability to integrate research with educational responsibilities.</li></ol>
3	<p><u>Innovation and Impact in Research</u></p> <p>The nominee's research should demonstrate innovation and have a measurable impact on the field of medicine or healthcare. This can include novel research approaches, significant discoveries, or contributions that have led to advancements in medical knowledge or practice.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>i. Description of innovative aspects of the nominee's research.</li><li>ii. Examples of the impact or application of research findings.</li><li>iii. Testimonials from experts in the field on the significance of the nominee's work.</li></ol>
