Any request for leave from the Main Paper would need to be supported with documentary proof e.g., MC, letter from employer etc. Those with valid reasons and supporting documents/proofs will be given due consideration to attempt for the Supplementary Paper. The supporting documents have to be submitted in advance before the Main Paper.
- 5. Students who failed a course are given a chance to attempt the Final Examination Supplementary Paper for the course.
