



Master of Education (Malay Language)

This specialisation provides education professionals with functionally integrated academic, experiment and field based study of Malay Language Education. Research theories and methods in investigating Malay language, literature and culture in their socio-cultural contexts will be offered together with current practices and advances in Malay Language curriculum development and pedagogy for schools. This specialisation offers theoretical grounding in the Malay language and Malay literature and culture research, as well as the opportunity to investigate the intersection of these fields with language teaching and learning. It enhances the research skills and knowledge base of teachers and other professionals in language education.



Target Audience

Educators and university graduates with a background in education who wish to advance their knowledge and skills in Malay Language education.



Entry Requirement

- · A good Bachelor's degree from a recognised university.
- · A teaching qualification such as the Postgraduate Diploma in Education from NIE; OR At least ONE year of relevant working experience in education.
