3MT® Presentation Submission Guidelines

The submission for 3MT® presentation should observe the following word limits:

Title: 15 words

Abstract: 300 words

*The maximum word count of 300 words does NOT include the title, author's name, or name of school.

What to Include

The abstract should include (but is not limited to) the following content:

- A brief mention of key literature and research gaps.
- Your research question(s) or reason(s) for the topic being addressed.
- a brief mention of key findings, discussions, or arguments.

3MT® Competition Rules

- A single static PowerPoint slide is permitted. No slide transitions, animations or 'movement' of any description are allowed. The slide is to be presented from the beginning of the oration.
- No additional electronic media (e.g., sound and video files) are permitted.
- No additional props (e.g., costumes, musical instruments, laboratory equipment) are permitted.
- Presentations are limited to 3 minutes maximum and competitors exceeding 3 minutes are disqualified.
- There will be a timer placed in front of you to help you keep track of your presentation time. Presentations are to be spoken word (e.g., no poems, raps or songs).
- Presentations are to commence from the stage.
- Presentations are considered to have commenced when a presenter starts their presentation through either movement or speech.
- The decision of the adjudicating panel is final.
