Abstract

The big questions refer to questions asked at the beginning of a lesson. Students respond, and the lesson follows. It is an open approach. In the talk, the speaker will describe how lessons can be conducted using the idea of "big questions". In the process, the speaker will elaborate a possible framework for such an approach.

Mr Huang Aihua is the Head of Department of Continuing Education, Shenzhen Academy of Educational Sciences. He was appointed Master Teacher of primary mathematics in Guangdong province and was awarded the National Outstanding Teacher Award in 1995. He has been been involved in the teaching and learning of primary mathematics for 27 years now. He was a classroom teacher, vice-principal and now a researcher and teacher trainer.
