Abstract

Talk 1: ATCM 2014 Yogyakarta

Keng Cheng will provide a short report on ATCM 2014, briefly discuss his presentations and share his views on the future of the ATCM, which stands for Asian Technology Conference in Mathematics. The first ATCM conference was held in Singapore in 1995, hosted by NIE. The purpose of this conference series is to facilitate and encourage discussions and debates on the use of computers and software in mathematics research and teaching among Asian nations. While serving communities in Asia, ATCM has always been able to attract a core group of international participants outside of Asia, and the nineteenth edition, ATCM 2014, was no different. Held in Yogyakarta, renowned as a centre of education (*Kota Pelajar*) and richly endowed with Javanese culture and history, ATCM 2014 was hosted by Yogyakarta State University and organized in cooperation with QITEP in Mathematics, Indonesia.
