Beginning of a journey in mentoring teachers to foster metacognition in students by Dr. Dawn Ng

Metacognition has been a key feature in the Singapore Mathematics Curriculum Framework for more than twenty years. Limited formal investigations into teachers' metacognitive instructional practice in Singapore mathematics classrooms (e.g., Lee, Yeo, & Hong, 2014; Loh, 2015; Ng, 2010) as well as anecdotal evidence suggest that metacognition, both as a concept and as a habit of mind in practice, is still rather elusive to many teachers and students. Dawn will share some preliminary findings from a research study on teachers' conceptions and their purported practices to foster student metacognition in their mathematics classrooms.
