# 1 Conditions of Admission

The offer of a place at the National Institute of Education, Nanyang Technological University, Singapore (NIE NTU, Singapore) is made to you subject to the following conditions:

- a) NTU is satisfied that you are certified fit to study by NTU's doctor at NTU's Medical Center.
- b) The information you have given in your application form is valid, true, and accurate and you have not withheld any material information from NTU.

# 2 Matriculation

Matriculation involves the following:

- a) Obtain matriculation number
- b) Submission of documents
- c) E-matriculation
- d) Obtain NIE Login Account Details
- e) Obtain NTU E-mail Account
- f) Obtain Student Matriculation Card

## a) Obtain Matriculation Number

A matriculation number will be given to you upon completing the NTU online acceptance form. E-matriculation with NIE is still required (see point 2c).

# c) E-Matriculation

New students are required to do e-matriculation through <a href="https://portal.nie.edu.sg/ereg/register/stdregform.jsp">https://portal.nie.edu.sg/ereg/register/stdregform.jsp</a>.

Those who complete the NTU online acceptance form on or before 2 June 2024 can e-matriculate from 6 June 2024.

Those who complete the NTU online acceptance form from 3 June 2024 onwards can e-matriculate 3 days after, e.g., 3 June+3 days=6 June 2024; 5 June+3 days=8 June 2024.

You are encouraged to matriculate promptly to obtain the NIE Portal login account and NTU email account.

If you encounter problems accessing the website, please contact the ACIS Service Desk at 6790 3033 or visit the IT & Infra Services Hub at NIE Student Hub (UiD), Level 1.

# d) Obtain NIE Login Account Details

During the e-matriculation, you will be advised to provide a valid email address and local mobile number. Your NIE Login account details will be sent to you via email. If you do not receive your NIE Login account details within 3 days after you have successfully completed the e-matriculation or if you encounter problems accessing the NIE Portal, please contact the ACIS Service Desk at 6790 3033 or visit UiD, Level 1.

## e) Obtain NTU E-mail Account

Students will be issued an NTU email account (i.e., an educational account ending with @e.ntu.edu.sg) 7 days after e-matriculation. This email account is proof of your identity as a student of the University and will be the primary communication channel between you and the University. Students can log in to the NIE portal, click on your name at the top right corner, and click on 'About Me' to retrieve the NTU email account details (ID and Password) 7 days after e-matriculation.

## f) Student Matriculation Card

# 3 Health Screening

All students must undergo a health screening prior to admission to determine their medical fitness to pursue the programme of study at the University. # 4 Apply for Student's Pass (For Full-Time International students only)

The offer of admission is conditional upon you being issued a valid Student's Pass by the Singapore Immigrations and Checkpoints Authority (ICA).

The instructions on how to apply for Student's Pass will be given to newly matriculated students. If you do not have a passport, you should apply for one to facilitate your travel arrangements.

If your application for the Student's Pass is successful, it will be approved together with the required visa for entry to Singapore. ICA will inform you separately via email when your Student's Pass application has been approved.

The above information on Student's Pass application and ICA's restrictions are subject to the prevailing Singapore Government's regulations at the material time.

# 5 Student Housing on NTU Campus

The undergraduate freshmen hall application period starts from 4 June 2024, 9 am (SGT) till 24 June 2024, 5 pm (SGT). You will need the NTU e-mail account to apply for housing. As it takes about 7 days after e-matriculation to get your NTU e-mail account, freshmen should complete the NTU acceptance and NIE e-matriculation as early as possible. ## 6 Qualifying English Test

The <u>Qualifying English Test</u> (QET) will be held on **Wednesday**, **7 August 2024** in the afternoon. This will be an in-person online test, held in the test venues and details on preparation for the e-test will be updated on the website in June 2024. Please visit the <u>website</u> for more details about the QET.

Students will be admitted into the test hall **twenty (20) minutes** before the start of the e-test to check and ensure there are no technical issues before commencement of the QET.

If you are required to take the QET, the details of the e-test will be displayed on the screen. It is crucial that you check the details before the e-test.

## 9 Commencement of Programme

GST on the subsidized fees is subsidized by MOE for Singapore Citizens and Permanent Residents

The Singapore Government provides tuition grants to assist students in paying a substantial part of the full tuition fees chargeable by NIE. Students who wish to receive the tuition grant may declare by logging in to the NIE Portal. Under Student Dashboard > Favourites, click on e-Forms. Expand the Tuition Grant Declaration and click on the "Tuition Grant Declaration" to access and submit the form.

For Singapore Permanent Residents/ International Students accepting their admission programme offer with Tuition Grant, please register online for Tuition Grant at the MOE website. After TG registration period closed, students who had registered for TG are to download their personalised Tuition Grant Agreement (TGA) from the TGOnline system. Students and their sureties are to sign on the TG agreement and email a softcopy of the signed TG agreement and sureties' ID to finaid@ntu.edu.sg by 23 September 2024.

For Singaporean students who have accepted both their admission programme offer and MOE TG offer, there is no need to register for TG at the Ministry of Education's website. In connection with the above, students who have recently become Singapore citizens must submit a copy of the Singapore Citizenship Certificate and Singapore Identity Card together in order for their citizenship to be updated in the database.

## 11 GIRO Application

Students are required to pay fees through GIRO. Similarly, credits, if any, will be received through GIRO. In view of this, a GIRO application form is enclosed for your use. You are required to complete the form and submit the original signed hard copy (as required by the bank) to NIE Student Services Centre. Digital signatory is not acceptable by the bank. Kindly note not to use correction fluid/tape and all amendments must be countersigned. You are requested to submit only one GIRO application form for the whole programme of study unless there is a change in the standing instruction from the Finance Department.

Students will be informed of the exact date of GIRO deduction or credit via e-Invoice in the NIE Portal (<a href="https://portal.nie.edu.sg">https://portal.nie.edu.sg</a>) or in the MOE notification letters. Please note that only banks domiciled in Singapore are to be used for GIRO.

Possible GIRO transactions include deduction for tuition fees, credit for reimbursements and allowances, if any.

## 12 Financial Assistance Schemes

#### **CPF Education Loan Scheme**

This is for students who are interested to withdraw CPF funds from parents/own CPF account to pay tuition fees.

# Mendaki Tertiary Tuition Fee Subsidies

Mendaki Tertiary Tuition Fees Subsidy (TTFS) Scheme is an education subsidy for Singaporean/Singapore Permanent Resident Malay students pursuing full-time undergraduates programme, which covers up to their subsidized tuition fee. Apply online at Mendaki's website <a href="https://my.mendaki.org.sg">https://my.mendaki.org.sg</a> during application period. Please select "National Institute of Education" as the Institution.

## Tuition Fee Loan Scheme

Full-time undergraduates of all nationalities regardless of family income can obtain a Tuition Fee Loan (TFL) of up to 90% of the subsidised tuition fee payable by Singapore Citizens for the same programme. The loan does not cover miscellaneous fees and hall rental charges. Interest free during study years with interest and repayment commence upon graduation. # Post Secondary Education Account (PSEA)

PSEA scheme is administered by the Ministry of Education (MOE) which allows students to utilize the funds in their own and/or their siblings' PSEA accounts for the payment of tuition/miscellaneous fees, selected fees and costs.

# Loans and Bursaries Administered by NTU Shared Services Financial Aid

The Study Loan must be held concurrently with one or combination of the schemes – MOE Tuition Fee Loan/CPF Education Loan Scheme / Mendaki Tertiary Tuition Fee Subsidy / Mendaki Loan / Post Secondary Education Account, where applicable. It will provide a loan to finance the part of the subsidised fees payable by Singapore Citizens not covered by the above Scheme and offers an optional living allowance loan of up to \$\$3,600 per academic year. Loan is interest free during study years with interest and repayment commencing upon graduation.

Bursaries are open for application to financially needy full-time undergraduates of all nationalities with family's gross monthly PCI/GHI <= \$2,500/\$10,000.

## 14 Attire

Every student is expected to wear suitable clothing and maintain a hairstyle that gives an appearance of neatness and decorum. Outlandish and flashy clothing as well as long and unkempt hairstyles are prohibited on campus; likewise for inappropriate footwear such as sandals and slippers. Information on the dress code for students can be found in the NIE Portal.

## 15 Absence from Class

Students who cannot attend classes for any valid reason must apply for leave.

If advanced notification of lecturers/tutors is not possible, it is the onus of students to contact their lecturers/tutors to explain the reasons for their absence no later than 2 working days from the date of absence. Those who fail to do so will be issued with a notice of absence letter.

Applications for leave must be made on the appropriate leave application forms which can be obtained from the NIE Portal at <a href="https://portal.nie.edu.sg">https://portal.nie.edu.sg</a> under Academics > Non-ITP Programme > Sport Science & Management (SSM). Applications for leave of absence must be submitted at least 7 days in advance to the SSM programme office at <a href="mailto:ssm@nie.edu.sg">ssm@nie.edu.sg</a>. Where the leave is for the purpose of participating in competitions, the application should be submitted at least one month in advance to allow for processing. Students should not go on leave until approval has been obtained. Late leave applications will not be considered.

Where the absence is due to medical reasons, students are required to produce medical certificates issued by medical practitioners registered under the Medical Registration Act. Students are required to upload a clear picture of their medical certificate (MC) via the NIE Portal or the NIE mobile app within 1 week from the date of issue of the MC and submit a copy of it to <a href="mailto:ssm@nie.edu.sg">ssm@nie.edu.sg</a>. They must also show the original MC to the lecturers/tutors when they are back in class. After 1 week, a notice of absence from class will be issued to students who fail to explain the reasons for absence.

Students who are likely to be on long absence (i.e. semester leave of absence) during semester/curriculum time are required to inform SSM programme office at <a href="mailto:ssm@nie.edu.sg">ssm@nie.edu.sg</a> about their intentions before applying, after which, the Assistant Dean, SSM will advise them on any implications of their absence before it commences. Implications include but are not limited to additional semester(s) required to complete the programme of study and hence may result in additional cost to the students.

Students may leave for holidays overseas during public holidays, weekends and the NIE vacation as long as there are no programme commitments to fulfill during the period concerned.

## 16 Withdrawal

Students leaving the programme prematurely will be required to immediately inform SSM programme office at <a href="mailto:ssm@nie.edu.sg">ssm@nie.edu.sg</a> of their withdrawal in writing. The withdrawal will take effect only from the date of endorsement by NIE. Matriculated students who submit their withdrawal after Teaching Week 2 of the semester will be liable to pay the tuition and miscellaneous fees for the entire semester.



GIRO is a convenient, cashless mode of payment. To help you better understand the GIRO payment method, here are some answers to the most frequently raised questions on GIRO:

#### 1. How do I get started?

Complete this GIRO application form, with your customer/account/bill number. Please <u>submit the GIRO form in hardcopy with original ink signature</u>. Digital signatory is not acceptable by the bank. Kindly note not to use correction fluid / tape and all amendments <u>must be countersigned</u>. Send it back to us at:

#### 2. How long do I need to wait before my GIRO arrangement is effective?

Continue paying by cash or cheque for all your bills until your GIRO arrangement is effected. Your GIRO application is only effective when the statement 'Amount will be deducted from your account on ddmmyyyy' appears on your bill.

#### 3. Can I arrange for another party to effect the GIRO arrangement through his/her bank account or pay for another party?

Yes, you can by stating his/her name and contact number, and the customer/account/bill number on the GIRO form.

#### 4. What happens if there are insufficient funds in my bank account?

We will inform you to pay by other ways. However, you should still maintain sufficient funds in your bank account for the subsequent due date.

Please note that some banks do charge a service fee for unsuccessful GIRO deduction due to insufficient funds.

# 5. I have existing financial aid (CPF, Mendaki, Bank Loan (TFL and/or Study Loan), Sponsorships and etc) for payment of tuition fees and/or miscellaneous fees. Why do I still need to submit GIRO application form?

Certain financial aid can only pay for tuition fees (e.g. CPF, Mendaki, TFL). GIRO is the most convenient method to pay for the remaining tuition fees, miscellaneous fees and hostel fees. Students are required to pay fees through GIRO. Similarly, credits, if any, will be received through GIRO. Possible GIRO transactions include credit for reimbursements, bursaries and other allowances, if any.
